

## Liquefied e-methane big in Japan

The 6<sup>th</sup> Methanation workshop took place 1-2 June 2023 in Nuremberg, Germany.

The conference was organised by the Friedrich-Alexander-Universität Erlangen-Nürnberg (FAU) and attracted 100 participants from 11 countries.

Motoki Yoshida, Tokyo Gas, gave a presentation about the company's ambition to become climate neutral by 2050.

Tokyo Gas is one of the largest utilities in Japan, importing 12.6 Mton LNG (FY2021) and serving 8.7 million natural gas customers (March 2022). The development of a liquefied e-methane market is of great importance to support the company's environmental ambitions.
