



University of Calgary is now officially part of the CarbonNeutralLNG project

As mentioned in the Newsletter nr 2-2023, <https://gansub.com/t/pm/5867882341107/>, University of Calgary will be part of the CarbonNeutralLNG project. The legal departments have now finalised the negotiations and the partnership is official.

University of Calgary (UoC) brings in expertise on life cycle emissions for both natural gas and biomass supply chains. UoC will investigate the life cycle emissions of North American biomass converted into green LNG and shipped to Europe using the existing LNG and natural gas infrastructure and evaluate what it will take to make this pathway carbon neutral.
