The workshop on Social acceptance and barriers for bioLNG was held on the 23rd of January 2025 as part of the CarbonNeutralLNG project.

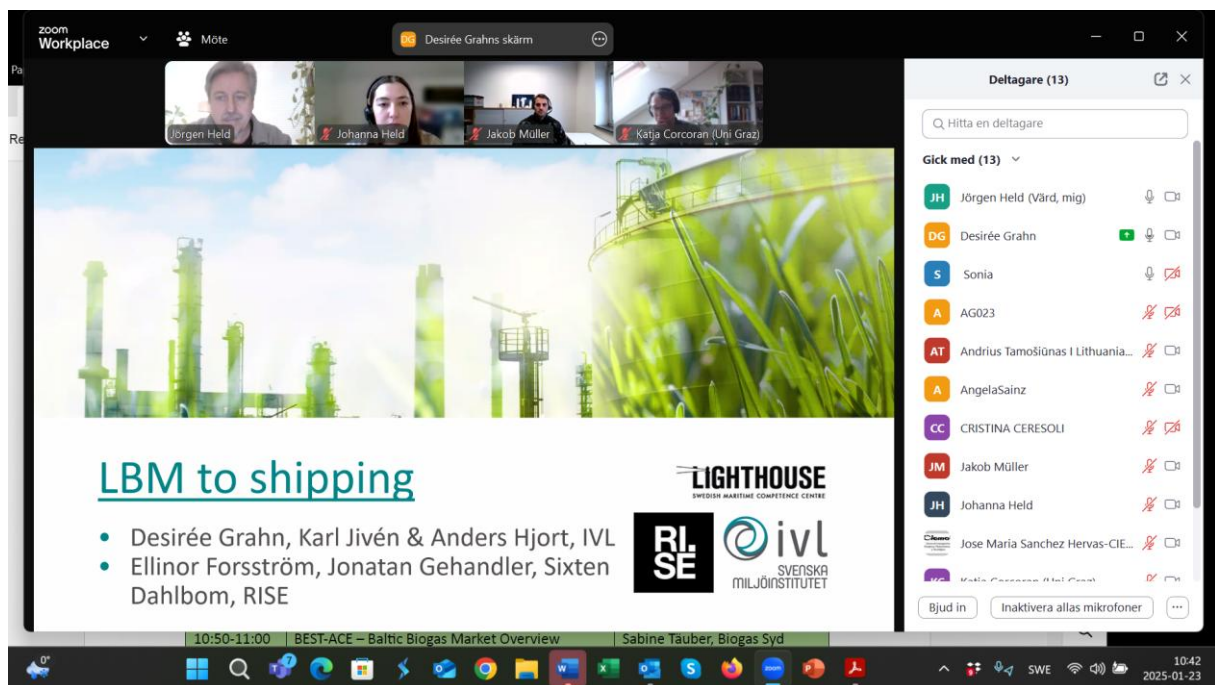
The workshop started with an [introduction to the CarbonNeutralLNG project](#) by Jakob Müller, FAU.

The workshop ended with a good discussion on both opportunities and barriers for bioLNG and compressed biomethane. While new [filling stations](#) for biomethane (both compressed and liquefied) are popping up in Europe, it is obvious that the unilateral focus on electrification by the politicians, both on national and EU level, has a negative impact on the development of biomethane, especially for passenger cars.
